New Car Seat Simulator Enhances Car Seat Program

New Day Center was able to purchase a Car Seat Training Simulator earlier this year with a grant from Roseville Area Community Foundation. This portable hands-on training aid includes various safety belt systems found in vehicles today with the purpose of training



parents on how to properly install their new infant/child car seat. The training seat is used indoors, independent of the client's automobile. Gone are the days when car seat installation was demonstrated outdoors in winter weather and in the busy Thrift Store parking lot!



The parent first learns to install their child's new car seat and then properly buckles their child into the seat. If the child is not available, the client demonstrates with one of New Day's child-sized dolls.

Center Adopts New Program Guidelines

New Day Center has unfortunately not found the part time Client Services Mentor for which we prayed and advertised. As a result, we recently modified program guidelines to allow us to accept new clients while continuing to serve existing clients. New guidelines require that when a family's youngest child is fully potty trained or reaches 4 years of age, that family will graduate from the program. This age limit coincides with preschool entry and access to public school prekindergarten services. Of course, the love of Jesus will always compel us to assist any family that comes to our door with immediate physical needs.
